## **CORRUPTION RISK ASSESSMENT, ETHICS AND INTEGRITY TRAINING WORKSHOP FOR THE NAMIBIAN POLICE IN KUNENE REGION, 07 – 10 MAY 2019.**

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) embarked on a four-day workshop on Corruption Risk Assessment, Ethics and Integrity training for the Namibian Police Force in the Kunene Region from the 07 – 10 May 2019. The workshop aims to educate the participants about the rationale for the Corruption Risk Assessment, Ethics and Integrity and how they can identify and mitigate possible corruption risks in the Police Force. The workshop will result in tangible recommendations on how the Namibian Police Force in Kunene Region can deal with internal corruption risks, foster integrity within the force, and eventually how it contribute to the fight against corruption.

The four-day workshop is an opportunity for the participants to examine current systems, practices and procedures to identify loopholes in the Police Force within the region. Furthermore, to then develop a corruption mitigation plan to address the identified loopholes. Regional Commander of the Namibian Police Force in the Kunene Region, Commissioner, James Nderura, officially opened the workshop and urged all management cadres to take the workshop serious as it will help in making Kunene Region a better place to live, and free from crime including corruption. This workshop is expected to assist the Namibian Police Force in Kunene Region to come up with interventions to address their vulnerabilities to corruption. The workshop is attended by various NAMPOL Head of Divisions in the Kunene Region.

The workshop is part of the much anticipated realization of specific objectives provided for in the National Anti-Corruption Strategy and Action Plan, which entails the identification of corruption risks, the development and implementation of corruption risk mitigation strategies of an assessed institution.

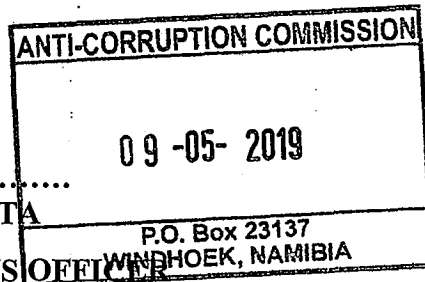
